Menu Specialties: **SPANAKOPITA** "raviolis" spinach and feta cheese in phyllo dough with toasted pine nuts and kalamata olives

ROASTED POTATOES slowly roasted in fresh herb oil, served with harissa mayonnaise

CRISPED CHICKPEAS AND OKRA delicious and crunchy, lightly fried

MUSHROOM CAP SOUP roasted portabella mushrooms pureed and served with a slice of portabella (vegan)

VEGAN PIZZET topped with arugula and dried apricots, drizzled with Aragon oil

SHRIMP FALAFEL house-made falafel stuffed with shrimp served with a trio of dipping sauces: artichoke sauce, fennel dip and harissa mayo

GRILLED OCTOPUS with harissa mango sauce with corn and chickpea salad

COLORADO SPICED LAMB CHOPS grilled lamb chops dredged in anchovy breadcrumbs served with stone ground mustard

CHICKEN BASTILLA 'WONTONS' chicken baked in filo dough with sweet almonds, served with a side of sautéed zucchini

SLOW-BRAISED LAMB SHANK served with fennel coriander sauce with curried basmati rice and chick pea vinaigrette

MEATBALL TAGINE beef meatballs in a tangy tomato sauce topped with a fried egg

BRIWATS (HOUSE SPECIALTY) - a North African variation of baklava – just better!
